According to tradition, there will be awards for:

#### No. 1 Best Oral Presentation

CHF 250.00 prize + 150.00 max refund for travel and accommodation

2-3 abstracts will be selected for the Short Oral Presentation in the Young Investigator Session. To be eligible for the Short Oral Presentation the presenting author should be a student, post doc, or similar levels. The job position of the presenting author should be clearly stated in the submission form.

#### INSTRUCTION FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

- Abstracts must be submitted electronically by e-mail
- Deadline for abstract submission is: June 30<sup>th</sup> 2024
- One single abstract per presenting author can be submitted; however, submitters can be co-authors on several abstracts.
- Final selection: Abstracts will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee and notification of their acceptance as oral presentation will be sent to the presenting author.

# It is mandatory including, after the abstract body:

- Name of the presenting author
- Current status of the presenting author (undergraduate student, graduate student, PhD student, Postdoctoral fellow, Assistant/Associate/ Full professor)
- E-mail and phone number of the presenting author

**PLEASE NOTE**: abstracts which do not follow instructions will be rejected.

### YOUNG INVESTIGATOR AWARD

The Swiss Narcolepsy Network (SNaNE) aims to promote clinical and scientific progress in the field of narcolepsy and other hypersomnias of central origin.

For the **9<sup>th</sup> European Narcolepsy Day** to be held in St. Gallen, on October, 24th 2024 the SNaNe will grant a "**Young Investigator Award**".

If you are an early carrier fellow (see definition below) and have published a basic or clinical research article on narcolepsy or hypersomnolence of central origin between January 2023 and February 2024, in a key position (first or co-first author), you are invited to apply for this award. Note that the young investigator prize can be obtained only once.

The award is a prize as well as an invitation to present the awarded scientific work at the 9th Swiss Narcolepsy Day in St. Gallen (it includes travel expenses for up to 250.00 CHF).

Young Investigators are defined as persons who are working in the field, who have been either awarded a doctoral degree (PhD or MD) within the past 5 years or are doing research and have less than 9 years research experience following master's degree or equivalent. Young Investigators should not hold an appointment as faculty, academic staff or group leader in a university/research institute or in industry. Young investigators are required to have their advisor/

supervisor send a letter as proof of the bona fide status of young investigator and mentioning in details the implication of the candidate in the publication.

Evaluation will be performed by the scientific committee with the help of external experts if needed to avoid conflict of interests.
